

## Public Funding Report: Arts and Culture

District 5

In fiscal year 2020\*, the **National Endowment for the Arts** invested **\$3,801,808** in **Massachusetts**, including \$959,600 in grants to the Mass Cultural Council. **The Mass Cultural Council** invested a total of **\$16,717,164** in the vibrant and diverse cultural life of Massachusetts through 2,533 grants. This also included \$4,154,000 for 329 local and regional cultural councils, representing all 351 cities and towns. These local councils invested \$5,069,636 into 7,002 projects in their communities. Additionally, **Massachusetts allocated \$9,302,400 from its capital budget** to 100 projects through the Cultural Facilities Fund. The following report has been compiled to demonstrate the breadth of the vital public investment in being made in District 5.

### Federal funding through the National Endowment for the Arts:

- 7 grants totaling \$240,000

### State funding through the Massachusetts Cultural Council:

- 219 grants totaling \$1,150,700

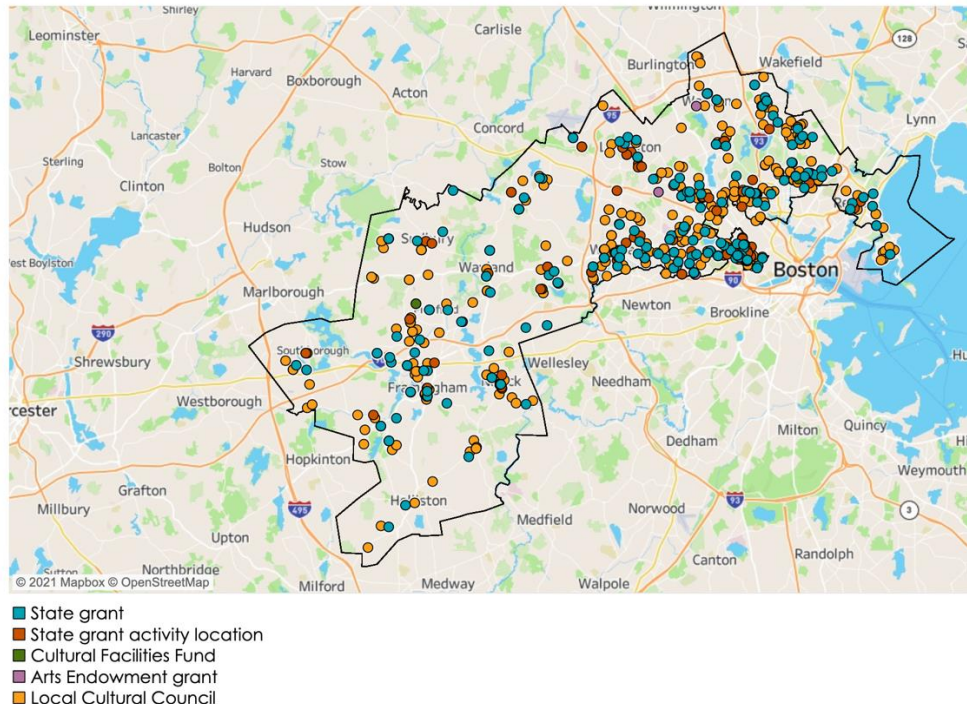
### State funding through the Cultural Facilities Fund:

- 8 grants totaling \$488,000

### Regranting by Local and Regional Cultural Councils:

- The Massachusetts Cultural Council allocated \$327,000 to 24 Cultural Councils that, in turn, invested \$519,350 in local projects through 571 grants

### Total Federal, State, and Local investment in District 5: **\$2,398,050**
